This Indenture made this Twenty fourth day of September in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and eighty one between Elmer B. Mann 2^d and Frank O. Mann his husband of the City of Lawrence in the County of Douglas and State of Kansas of the first part and Sarah H. Mann of the same place of the second part:

Witnesseth that the said parties of the first part in consideration of the sum of One Thousand Dollars to them duly paid the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged have sold and by these presents do grant bargain sell and mortgage to the said party of the second part this piece and assigns forever all that tract or parcel of land situated in the County of Douglas and State of Kansas described as follows to wit: Block Six Hundred Sixty in the City of Lawrence as numbered and designated on the plat of said City with the appurtenances and all the estate title and interest of the said parties of the first part therein. And the said Elmer B. Mann and Frank O. Mann do hereby covenant and agree that at the delivery hereof they are the lawful owners of the premises above granted and seized of a good and indefeasible estate of inheritance therein free and clear of all incumbrances. This mortgage is given to secure a part of the purchase money of said lot.
