Witnesseth that William H. Christian and Flora A. Christian husband and wife of the County of Douglas and State of Kansas party of the first part for and in consideration of Three hundred Dollars conveyed and Warrants to Richard J. Roberts party of the second part his heirs and assigns the real estate hereinafter described situated in the County of Douglas and State of Kansas to wit:

The West half of the South East quarter of Section number thirty six (36) Town number eleven (11) Range number Seventeen (17) East of the Sixth P.M. and containing eighty (80) acres more or less To secure the said party of the second part for an actual loan of money made to the said William H. Christian and Flora A. Christian as evidenced by one certain Bond No. Six thousand of Three hundred Dollars of our date herewith in and by which said bond the party of the first part promise to pay to the order of Richard J. Roberts in lawful money of the United States of America the principal sum of Three hundred Dollars five years after date thereof with interest thereon at the rate of seven per centum per annum interest payable semi annually, according to and upon presentation of interest coupons therefor thereto attached both principal and interest being payable at the National Bank of Commerce in New York City.

Also Providing that in case any interest or any of said sums shall remain unpaid for ten days after the same becomes due then the entire sum covered by said bond and secured by this Mortgage Deed to become immediately due and payable without any notice of any kind whatsoever the same to be collected in like manner as if the full time provided in said bond had expired.
