Witnesseth that John Henry Davis and Fingee Davis his wife in her own right of the County of Douglas and State of Kansas party of the first part for and in consideration of Five hundred Dollars currency and Warrants to Sarah J. Swift party of the second part hereinafter and assigns the real estate hereinafter described, situated in the County of Douglas and State of Kansas to wit: The West half of the West half of the North East quarter and the West half of the West half of the North Eleven (11) acres of the South East quarter of Section number Twenty six (26) Town Number Thirtieth (30) Range Number Eighty one (81) East of the Sixth P.M. and containing forty two and $\frac{3}{4}$ (42 $\frac{3}{4}$) acres more or less. To secure the said party of the second part for an actual loan of money made to the said John Henry Davis and Fingee Davis as evidenced and contained in and to the said bond and secured by Five hundred Dollars five years after date thirty with interest thereon at the rate of seven per centum per annum interest payable semi-annually according to and upon presentation of interest coupons therefor the amount of both principal and interest being payable at the National Bank of Commerce in New York City.
