Pasche her heirs and assigns forever, the following described real estate situated in the County of Douglas State of Kansas and being the South West quarter and the West half of the South East quarter of Section Thirty four (34) Township Twelve (12) and Range Twenty one (21) containing Two hundred and forty acres of land more or less and all the estate title and interest of the said Augustus F. Pasche either in law or in equity of in and to the said premises; Together with all the privileges and appurtenances to the same belonging and all the rents issues and profits thereof.
