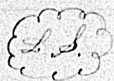

This Indenture made this 25<sup>th</sup> day of June in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and eighty one between William L. German and Elizabeth German of Willow Springs in the County of Douglas and State of Kansas of the first part and Silas Canvin of Marion in the County of Douglas and State of Kansas of the second part:

Witnesseth that the said parties of the first part for and in consideration of the sum of (\$25.00) Three Hundred Twenty five Dollars to them duly paid, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, have sold and by these presents do grant bargain sell and mortgage to the said party of the second part his heirs and assigns forever all that tract or parcel of land situate in the County of Douglas and State of Kansas and described as follows to wit: The East half (1/2) of the South East (1/4) quarter of Section (2) Two in Township (15) Fifteen of Range (11) Eighteen with the appurtenances and all the estate title and interest of the said parties of the first part therein.

This Grant is intended as a Mortgage to secure the payment of the sum of (\$25.00) Three Hundred and Twenty five Dollars according to the terms of two certain promissory notes described as follows:

No. One dated June 25<sup>th</sup> A.D. 1881 amount \$100.00 due December 25<sup>th</sup> A.D. 1881. and No. Two dated June 25<sup>th</sup> A.D. 1881 to the amount of \$25.00 due June 25<sup>th</sup> A.D. 1883. Said notes signed by parties of the first part.

And this conveyance shall be void if such payment be made as is herein specified. But if default be made in said payment or any part thereof as provided then this conveyance shall become absolute and it shall be lawful for said party of the second part his executor administrators and assigns at any time thereafter to sell the premises hereby granted or any part thereof in the manner prescribed by law and out of all the moneys arising from such sale to retain the amount then due for principal and interest and also for statute
