This Indenture made this eighteenth-day of October in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and eighty and sixteen Elizabeth Finkey of Marion in the County of Douglas and State of Kansas of the first part and Harriet M. Andrew of the second part. Witnesseth that the said party of the first part in consideration of the sum of Two Hundred and Fifty Dollars to her duly paid the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged has sold and by these presents does grant bargain sell and mortgage to the said party of the second part her heirs and assigns forever all that tract or parcel of land situated in the County of Douglas and State of Kansas described as follows to wit: One undivided one third (1/3) of a one half (1/2) interest in the North half of the South west quarter of Section number Fifteen (15) in Township number Fifteen (15) of Range number eighteen is containing Eighty (80) acres more or less. Also the same interest in Tracts (15) acres and ninety (90) rods described as follows to wit: Commencing at a point Twenty four and one half (24 1/2) rods north of the South West corner of Section number fourteen (14) in Township fifteen (15) of Range Eighteen (18) and running thence east sixty six (66) rods thence north thirty and one half (30 1/2) rods thence West sixty six (66) rods thence south to the place of beginning with the appurtenances and all the estate title and interest of the said party of the first part therein. And the said Elizabeth Finkey does hereby covenant and agree that at the delivery hereof she is the lawful owner of the premises above granted and seized of a good and indefeasible estate of inheritance therein free and clear of all incumbrances.

This Grant is intended as a Mortgage to secure the payment of the sum of Two Hundred Dollars according to the terms of two certain notes this day executed by the said Elizabeth Finkey to the said party of the second part: one note of one hundred dollars due Oct 15th 1882, and one note of one hundred dollars
