This Indenture made this first day of December  
in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and  
eighty one (A.D. 1881) between Alfred K Johnson and Helen  
M Johnson, his wife of Lawrence in the County of Douglas,  
and State of Kansas of the first part, and Dallie E Woodward,  
of Chester County, Pennsylvania of the second part.

Witnesseth, that the said parties of the first part, for and  
in consideration of the sum of Five Hundred (\$500.00) Dollars  
to them in hand paid by the said party of the second part, the  
receipt whereof is hereby confessed and acknowledged have  
granted, bargained, sold and conveyed, and by these presents  
do grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the said party of  
the second part and to her heirs and assigns forever all the  
following described piece and parcel of land lying ~~and~~  
and situate in the city of Lawrence, County of Douglas  
State of Kansas to wit; Lots numbered eight (8) and  
Nine (9), in Block four (4), in Laris first Addition to  
the City of Lawrence, said Lots fronting East on Mississippi  
Street and West on Illinois Street in said City of Lawrence  
and being each fifty feet wide and two hundred and  
fifty feet long.

To have and to hold the same with all and singular the  
hereditaments and appurtenances thereto belonging unto  
the party of the second part and to her heirs and assigns forever  
And the said Alfred K Johnson and Helen M Johnson, his wife  
do hereby covenant and agree that at the delivery hereof they  
are the lawful owners of the premises above granted and  
seized of a good and indefeasible estate of inheritance therein  
free and clear of all incumbrances and that they will warrant  
and defend the same in the quiet and peaceable possession  
of the said party of the second part their heirs and as-  
signs forever against all persons lawfully claiming the same  
Provided Always, And these presents are upon this express con-  
dition that whereas the said Alfred K Johnson and Helen M.  
Johnson are justly indebted unto the said Dallie E Woodward  
in the principal sum of Five Hundred (\$500.00) dollars law-  
ful money of the United States of America, being for a loan  
made on the day <sup>2nd</sup> date being made by the said Dallie E.  
Woodward to the said Alfred K Johnson and Helen M.  
Johnson his wife and secured to be paid by one certain  
promissory note of the said Alfred K. Johnson and Helen M.  
Johnson his wife bearing even date herewith payable to  
the order of the said Dallie E Woodward five (5) years  
from the date thereof at the office of A. H. Foote in the City  
of Lawrence and State of Kansas with interest at the rate  
of eight per cent per annum from date until said
