This Instrument made this twenty fifth day of November in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and eighty one between Samuel A. Walderman and Emily S. Walderman his wife of Marion Township in the County of Douglas and State of Kansas of the first part and Walker M. Heatman of Hamilton in the County of Butler and State of Ohio of the second part:

Witnesseth that the said parties of the first part for and in consideration of the sum of Five Hundred Dollars to them duly paid the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged have sold and by these presents do grant bargain sell and mortgage to the said parties of the second part his heirs and assigns forever all that tract or parcel of land situate in the County of Douglas and State of Kansas and described as follows to wit: The North East quarter of Section number 19 nine Township 22 North Range 25 East with the appurtenances and all the estate title and interest of the said parties of the first part therein. This grant is intended as a Mortgage to secure the payment of the sum of Five hundred and ninety Dollars according to the terms of five certain promissory notes of even date herewith made by the said Samuel A. Walderman and Emily S. Walderman payable to the order of Walker M. Heatman with interest from maturity at the rate of twelve per cent per annum as follows: one note for five hundred dollars being the principal note payable five years after date also four other notes being interest notes for 22⁵⁰ cents ³⁰ hundred two ³⁰ dollars each payable as follows one payable Dec. 25. 1852 one payable Nov. 25th 1853 one payable Nov. 25. 1853 and one payable Nov. 25 1854
