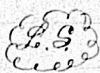

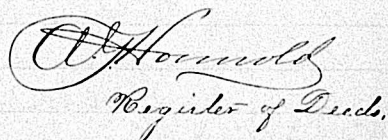

This Indenture made this 27th day of May in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and eighty one between Carl R. Hyler and Frederick Hyler his wife of Lawrence in the County of Douglas and State of Kansas of the first part and Frank L. Woodruff of the same place of the second part:

Witnesseth that the said parties of the first part in consideration of the sum of Five Hundred Dollars to them duly paid the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged have sold and by these presents do grant bargain sell and Mortgage to the said party of the second part his heirs and assigns forever all that tract or parcel of land situated in the County of Douglas and State of Kansas described as follows to wit: Lot Number Thirty Six on Rhode Island Street in the City of Lawrence according to survey and plat made by A. D. Seal described as follows commencing at the north-east corner of Rhode Island and Henry Streets two hundred feet from said corner: thence east one hundred and seventeen feet thence north fifty feet thence west one hundred and seventeen feet thence south fifty feet to place of beginning with the appurtenances and all the estate title and interest of the said part of the first part therein. And the said parties of the first part do hereby consent and agree that at the delivery hereof there are the lawful owners of the premises above granted and seized of a good and indefeasible estate of inheritance therein free and clear of all incumbrances.
