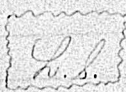

Witnesseth That said party of the first part in
 consideration of the sum of Two Hundred and 50/100 Dollars
 the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged do by these
 presents grant bargain sell and convey unto said party of
 the second part his heirs and assigns all the following
 described Real Estate situated in the County of Douglas and
 State of Kansas to wit The North West 1/4 of the South
 East 1/4 of Section Twelve (12) Town Thirteen (13) Range
 Seventeen (17)

To Have and to hold the same Together with all and
 singular the tenements hereditaments and appurtenances
 unto belonging or in any wise appertaining forever
 Provided Always And these presents are upon this express
 condition that whereas said Benjamin W. Harrell has this day
 executed and delivered one promissory note in writing to said
 party of the second part of which the following is a copy
