The intention being to convey hereby an absolute title in fee simple including all the rights of Homestead to have and to hold the premises above described with all the appurtenances thereto belonging unto the said John W. Gasner and to his heirs and assigns forever provided always and these presents are upon the express condition that if the said Hattie C. Frakes heirs executors or administrators shall pay or cause to be paid to the said John W. Gasner his heirs executors administrators or assigns the sum of Five hundred and seventeen ~~50~~ Dollars on the 1st day of January
