Witnesseth That the said party of the first part for and in consideration of the sum of Two Thousand Dollars to them in hand paid by the said party of the second part the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged have granted, bargained and sold^{and} by these presents do Grant, Bargain Sell Convey^{and} Confirm unto the said party of the second part^{and} to his heirs^{and} assigns forever all of the following described tract, piece, or parcel of land lying^{and} situate in the County of Douglas^{and} State of Kansas to wit; Lots Numbers One (1) Three (3) Five (5) Seven (7)^{and} Nine (9)ⁱⁿ New Hampshire Street in the City of Lawrence^{and} County of Douglas. To have and to hold the same with all and singular the Hereditaments^{and} appurtenances therunto belonging or in anywise appertaining^{and} all rights of homestead exemption unto the said party of the second part^{and} to his heirs^{and} assigns forever. And the said party of the first part do hereby covenant and agree that at the delivery hereof they are the lawful owners of the premises above granted and seized of a good^{and} indefeasible estate of inheritance therein free and clear of all incumbrances^{and} that they will Warrant^{and} Defend the same in the just^{and} peaceable possession of the said party of the second part,
