

reappointment of another trustee which may be made by any United States court or State court in the State of Kansas having jurisdiction in the premises on application of the party of the first part or of the holder of a majority of said bonds such new trustee shall become vested for the purpose aforesaid with all the right interest and power requisite for the execution of the purposes of this trust without any further or other authority release or conveyance of the same, but should it be advisable or necessary both or either of the parties hereto shall execute and deliver any and all necessary releases or conveyances for that purpose. And the said party of the second part does hereby accept the trust created by these presents.
