This Indenture made this 10th day of January in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and eighty two between the Lawrence and Emporia Railway Company a corporation created under the laws of Kansas, party of the first part and John F. Dillon and Peter B. Muschoff of the City and State of New York parties of the second part.

Witnesseth, Whereas said party of the first part is authorized by its charter and certificate of incorporation and by the laws of the State of Kansas to mortgage and to execute deeds of trust of the whole or any part of its railroad property and franchises, to pay its debts and to secure money borrowed for the purpose of aiding in and paying for the construction and equipment of its railroad and

Whereas to enable said company to raise money for the purpose of completing its railroad from its junction with the railroad of the Union Pacific Railway company in Lawrence to Emporia and also to enable it to discharge certain obligations incurred in the purchase of certain railroad property and of other legitimate purposes and to secure by a first lien on all its railroad constructed and to be constructed the payment of the principal and interest of the bonds hereinafter described the said party of the first part has determined to issue its coupon bonds to an amount not exceeding in the aggregate fifteen thousand dollars per mile of completed railroad said bonds to be numbered from one upwards with interest at six per cent per annum payable semi-annually
