This Indenture made this tenth day of February in the year of our Lord and thousands eight hundred and eighty two between Troy Shadle as Julia Shadle his wife of Lawrence in the County of Douglas and State of Kansas of the first part and Albert Messenger of the second part:

Witnesseth that the said parties of the first part in consideration of the sum of five hundred Dollars to them duly paid the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged have sold and by these presents do grant bargain sell and mortgage to the said party of the second part his heirs and assigns forever all that lot or parcel of land situated in the County of Douglas and State of Kansas and described as follows to wit: Lot numbered Twenty two (22) and twenty four (24) on New Jersey Street and Lot numbered Nine (9) Eleven (11) and Thirteen (13) on Pennsylvania Street in the City of Lawrence said County and State with the appurtenances and all the estate title and interest of the said parties of the first part therein.

And the said Troy Shadle does hereby covenant and agree that at the delivery hereof he is the lawful owner of the premises herein granted and seised of a good and indefeasible estate of inheritance therein free and clear of all incumbrances.
