This Indenture made this first day of October in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and eighty one between John H. Bullock & Clara J. Bullock his wife & Bryant Porter & Elmina Porter his wife in the County of Douglas and State of Kansas of the first part & The Western Land Mortgage Company of Lawrence Kansas of the second part:

Witnesseth that the said parties of the first part in consideration of the sum of Sixty Dollars to them duly the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged have sold and by these presents do grant bargain sell and convey to the said party of the second part the representations or assigns forever all that tract or parcel of land situated in the County of Douglas and State of Kansas described as follows to wit: Commencing at the South West corner of the South East Quarter of Section number Eleven (11) Township Number Thirteen (13) Range number eighteen (18) North and west line of said quarter Section Twenty (20) chains North and said west line to a point where said West line intersects the middle of the channel of the Okavuska Creek, Northeastly down the middle of channel of said creek to the point on the said creek known as the Kiny Ford; South easterly down the middle of the channel of said creek to a point South (17) chains South to the North line of said Quarter Section East to a point Eighteen and seventy five one hundredths (18⁷⁵/₁₀₀) chains East of the West line of said Quarter Section South to the South line of said Quarter Section, West Eighteen and seventy five one hundredths (18⁷⁵/₁₀₀) chains to beginning, Also the right of way across said ford, Thence south easterly along the North bank of said Creek
