This Indenture made this 11th day of March in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and eighty two between Wilton S Enslow and Anna R Enslow of Globe in the County of Douglas and State of Kansas of the first part and Alma R Wallace of in the County of Douglas and State of Kansas of the second part

Witnesseth That the said parties of the first part for and in consideration of the sum of Four Hundred Dollars to them duly paid the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged have sold and by these presents do grant bargain sell and mortgage to the said party of the second part her heirs and assigns forever all that tract or parcel of land situate in the County of Douglas and State of Kansas described as follows to wit; the West half of the North East quarter of Section No. Nine (9) Township No Fifteen (15), South of Range No Eighteen (18), East of 6th P.M. Kansas 80 acres, with the appurtenances and all the estate title and interest of the said parties of the first part therein.
