

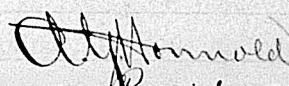

This Indenture Made this Fourteenth day of April in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and eighty-two between Thomas M^cLaughlin and Catharine M^cLaughlin his wife of the County of Douglasnd State of Kansas of the first part and Crippen Lawrencend of Concord New Hampshire of the second part.

Witnesseth, That the parties of the first part in consideration of the sum of Six Hundred and fifty Dollars to them in hand paid by the parties of the second part the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged have sold and by these presents do grant bargain sell and convey to the parties of the second part their heirs and assigns forever all that tract or parcel of land situated in the County of Douglasnd State of Kansas, described as follows to wit The North East Quarter of Section Number Twenty four 24, in Township Number Thirteen 13, of Range Number Twenty 20, East Containing One hundred sixty acres more or less, with the appurtenances and all the estate title and interest of the parties of the first part therein. And the said parties of the first part do hereby warrant and agree that at the delivery hereof they are the lawful owners of the premises above granted and seized in a good and indefeasible estate of inheritance therein free and clear of all incumbrances and that they will warrant and defend the same against all claims whatsoever.

This Grant is intended as a Mortgage to secure the payment of of the sum of Six hundrednd fifty Dollars according to the terms of one certain promissory bond made by the said parties of the first part to the parties of the second part, Said promissory bond being given for the sum of Six hundrednd

The following is endorsed on the original instrument
I have all paid by these parties. That Crippen Lawrence & Co. the mortgage within named, do hereby acknowledge full payment of the bond by the foregoing mortgage secured, and authorize the Register of Deeds of Douglas County, Kansas, to discharge the same of record.
