Woodward and Martha E. Woodward his wife of in the County of Douglas and State of Kansas of the first part and Crippen Lawrence & Co of the second part.

Witnesseth That the said parties of the first part in consideration of the sum of Three Hundred Dollars to them due, paid the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged have sold and by these presents do grant bargain sell and mortgage to the said parties of the second part their heirs and assigns forever all that tract or parcel of land situated in the County of Douglas and State of Kansas described as follows to wit The North East Quarter of Section No. Twenty four (24) the South East Quarter of Section No. Twenty Four (24), all in Township No. Fifteen (15), of Range No. Seventeen (17), East less, Fifteen (15) acres off the East side of said Section No. Twenty four (24), being a strip of even width from North side to Arkansas Creek and less the right of way as located for St Louis Lawrence and Denver Rail Road Co.
