

This Indenture Witnesseth, Whereas Martha A Harrison and Joseph W Harrison her Husband on the 11th day of April A.D. 1881 executed and delivered to the Kansas City Building Loan & Savings Association their certain Indenture of Mortgage Conveying the East fifty, 50, acres of the North half of the South West quarter of section No. 21 in township 12 of Range No. 19 In Trust to secure to said Association the Payment of a certain note of even date therewith for the sum of \$2000 due one year after date said note being given in purchase of the above described Land and said Land being situated in the County of Douglas and State of Kansas and whereas the said Martha A Harrison and Husband have fully paid off said note and Interest and are entitled to a full release and discharge of the same

Now Therefore Know all men by these presents that the Kansas City Building Loan and Savings Association of Kansas City, Mo. for and in consideration of the sum of One Dollar and the full payment of the note and interest above mentioned do by these presents permit release and quit claim unto them the said Martha A Harrison and Joseph W Harrison the Land first above described and so secured by said Indenture of Mortgage which is Recorded in Book 1 of Mortgages at page 316 Records of Douglas County, Kansas and do acknowledge satisfaction in full of said Note Interest and Mortgage and authorize the Register of Deeds of said Douglas County Kansas to discharge the same of Record
