

This Indenture Made this 28<sup>th</sup> day of February in the year  
of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and eighty two between  
Florence Horn and Perry Horn her Husband of Lawrence  
in the county of Douglas and State of Kansas of the first part  
and William Endicott Jr of the second part

Witnesseth That the said parties of the first part in considera-  
tion of the sum of Sixty Dollars to them duly paid the receipt  
of which is hereby acknowledged has sold and by these presents  
does grant Bargain sell and Mortgage to the said party of  
the second part his Heirs and assigns forever all that land  
or parcel of land situated in the County of Douglas and State  
of Kansas described as follows to wit Lots Numbered One Hundred  
and Sixty (160) and One Hundred and Sixty two (162) on Mississippi  
Street in the City of Lawrence with the appurtenances and all  
the estate title and interest of the said parties of the first  
part therein And the said Parties of the first part do hereby en-  
dorse and agree that at the delivery hereof they are law-  
ful owners of the premises above granted and seized of a  
good and marketable estate of inheritance clean free and  
of all encumbrances

This Grant is intended as a Mortgage to secure the pay-  
ment of the sum of Sixty Dollars with interest from date  
eight per cent per annum one year from date according  
the terms of one certain note this day executed and  
lived by the said Florence Horn & to the said Party of the  
second part and this conveyance shall be void if such pay-  
ment be made as herein specified But if default be made in the  
payment or any part thereof or interest thereon or the let-  
ter or if the insurance is not kept up thereon then this con-  
veyance shall become absolute and the whole shall  
come due and payable and it shall be lawful for the  
Party of the second part his executors administrators  
and assigns at any time thereafter to sell the premises  
hereby granted or any part thereof in the manner pre-  
scribed by law appraisement hereby waived or not  
at the option of the party of the second part his  
executors administrators or assigns and out of all  
the monies arising from such sale to retain the  
amount then due for principal and interest together  
with the costs and charges of making such sale and  
overplus if any there be shall be paid by the party  
making such sale on demand to the said Party of  
the first part their heirs or assigns
