

This Indenture Made this 26<sup>th</sup> day of April A.D.  
1882 between George Hilbert and Henrietta Hilbert his wife of  
Douglas County in the State of Kansas of the first part and  
August Hulftkull of no County in the State of no place part  
witnesseth That said parties of the first part in consid-  
eration of the sum of Five Hundred Dollars the receipt  
of which is hereby acknowledged do by these presents grant to  
gain sell and convey unto said party of the second part  
his heirs and assigns all the following described real estate  
situated in the County of Douglas and State of Kansas to wit  
The North West quarter of Section Twenty three (23) in  
Twpship Thirteen (13) of Range Seventeen (17) To have and to hold  
the same together with all the tenements hereditaments and  
appurtenances thereunto belonging or in any wise appertaining forever  
Provided always and these presents are upon this express condition  
that whereas said George Hilbert has this day executed and  
delivered a certain promissory note in writing to said  
party of the second part of which the following is a copy  
\$300<sup>00</sup>  
Lawrence Kas April 26 1882.

Five Years from date for value received I promise to  
pay to the order of August Hulftkull Five hundred dollars  
with interest from date at the rate of Three per cent per annum  
until paid payable annually

Signed George Hilbert.

Now, of said parties of the first part shall pay or cause  
to be paid to said party of the second part his heirs  
or assigns said sum of money as the above described  
note mentioned together with the interest thereon according  
to the terms and tenor of the same then these presents shall  
be wholly discharged and void and otherwise shall remain  
in full force and effect. But if said sum or sums of  
money or any part thereof or any interest thereon is not paid  
when the same is due and of the taxes and assessments  
of every nature which are or may be assessed or levied  
against said premises or any part thereof are not  
paid when the same are by law made payable then  
the whole of said sum and sums and interest thereon  
shall and by these presents become due and payable  
and said party of the second part shall be entitled  
to the possession of said premises
