This Indenture made this 1st day of May in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and eighty two between George D. Byrley and Eliza A. Byrley his wife of the County of Douglas and State of — of the first part and Silas Dodder of the same County and State of the second part:

Witnesseth - That the said parties of the first part in consideration of the sum of Three hundred Dollars to them duly paid, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, have sold and by these presents do grant bargain sell and mortgage to the said party of the second part - his heirs and assigns forever all that tract or parcel of land situated in the County of Douglas and State of Kansas described as follows to wit: The West half of the South-east quarter of Section Seven (7) in Township Fifteen (15) South of Range Eighth (8) East of Sixth P.M., containing eighty acres with the appurtenances and all the estate title and interest of the said parties of the first part therein. And the said parties of the first part do hereby covenant and agree that at the delivery hereof they are the lawful owners of the premises above granted and seized of a good and indefeasible estate of inheritance therein and will warrant and defend the same and that the same is free and clear of all incumbrances. This Grant is intended as a Mortgage to secure the payment of Three hundred Dollars in or
