

This Deed was made this 15 day of May 1882 between
 Edward T Bradford and wife Eliza E Bradford of Douglas County in
 the State of Kansas of the first part and S. L. Mead of in the State
 of New York of the second part.

Witnesseth, That the said parties of the first part in considera-
 tion of the sum of One Hundred and Fifty Dollars the receipt of
 which is hereby acknowledged do by these presents grant, bargain
 sell and convey unto the said party of the second part his heirs and
 assigns all the following described real estate, situated in the
 County of "Douglas" and State of Kansas, to wit Lot numbered one-
 hundred and Seventy, two 172 Rhode Island Street in the City of Lawrence
 being a size of Lot Fifty feet front by one hundred and Seventeen
 feet deep

To have and to hold the same together with all and singular
 the tenements, hereditaments and appurtenances thereto be-
 longing or in anywise appertaining forever and said parties of the
 first part hereby covenants that they are this day the owners of
 said premises that the same are free from all encumbrances
 and that they will warrant and defend the same to the grantee
 his heirs and assigns forever

Provided always, and these presents are upon this ex-
 press condition that whereas said parties of the first
 part have this day executed and delivered Eleven prom-
 issory notes in writing to said party of the second part pay-
 able at the Banking-House of John D Knox & Co, Topeka, Kansas
 bearing date May 15 1882 one principal note for \$150. due
 in five years after date and ten interest notes for \$6. each
 due in six months after date and one coming due at the
 end of each succeeding six months thereafter up to the ma-
 turity of the principal note; and all said notes bear 12 per
 cent interest after due until paid

That if said parties of the first part shall pay, or cause
 to be paid to said party of the second part his heirs and
 assigns, said sums of money in the above described
 notes mentioned together with the interest thereon, according
 to the terms and tenor of the same and shall pay all
 taxes and assessments which are or may be levied and
 assessed against said premises or any part thereof
 and shall pay the premiums for the amount of
 insurance hereinafter specified and shall keep the build-
 ings and fences on said premises in good repair,
 and refrain from cutting and removing wood and timber
 from said premises and from the commission of all

The following is endorsed on the original instrument
 The amount secured by the mortgage has been paid in full
