This Indenture made this 20th day of May in the year of our
Lord one thousand eight hundred and eighty-two between Henry J.
Bushner and Sarah C. Bushner his wife of Lawrence in the County of
Douglas and State of Kansas of the first part and Sara S. Crosby
of the second part:

Witnesseth that the said parties of the first part in consideration
of the sum of Two Thousand Dollars to them duly paid the receipt of
which is hereby acknowledged have sold and by these presents do grant
bargain sell and mortgage to the said party of the second part
his heirs and assigns forever all that tract or parcel of land situated
in the County of Douglas and State of Kansas described as follows
to wit:

The undivided One half (1/2) of the South-half (S 1/2) of Lot number
Twenty five (25) on Massachusetts Street in the City of Lawrence
according to the plat of said City with the appurtenances and all
State title and interest of the said parties of the first part therein.
And the said parties of the first part do hereby covenant and agree
that at the delivery hereof they are the lawful owners of the premises
above granted and receipt of a good and indefeasible estate of
inheritance therein free and clear of all incumbrances.

This Grant is intended as a mortgage to secure the payment of
the sum of Two Thousand Dollars and interest due \$400 in
years from May 1st 1882 and \$1000 in four years from May 1st 1886
with interest at 8 per cent per annum payable semi-annually.
