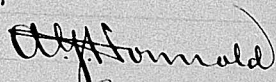

This Indenture made this 2^d day of June in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and eighty-two between William J. Raymond and Rose V. Raymond his wife of Lawrence in the County of Douglas and State of Kansas of the first part and Emily Cracklin of the second part:

Witnesseth that the said parties of the first part in consideration of the sum of Seven hundred (700) Dollars to them duly paid the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged have sold and by these presents do grant bargain sell and mortgage to the said party of the second part, her heirs and assigns forever all that tract or parcel of land situated in the County of Douglas and State of Kansas described as follows to wit:

Lot number Fifteen Pinkney Street in the City of Lawrence according to the plat of said City made by Holland & Heuler now in the office of the Register of Deeds of said Douglas County with the appurtenances and all the estate title and interest of the said parties of the first part therein. And the said William J. Raymond and Rose V. Raymond do hereby covenant and agree that at the delivery hereof they are the lawful owners owners of the premises above granted and seized of a good and indefeasible estate of inheritance therein free and clear of all incumbrances.

This Grant is intended as a Mortgage to secure the payment of the sum of Seven Hundred Dollars due on year after date at 7% interest payable semi annually according to the terms of one certain promissory note this day executed and delivered by the said William J. Raymond and Rose V. Raymond to said party of the second part; and this conveyance shall be void if such
