assigns said sum of money in the above described note
mentioned together with the interest thereon according to
the terms and tenor of the same then these presents shall
be wholly discharged and void and otherwise shall remain
in full force and effect. But if said sum or sums of mon-
ey or any part thereof or any interest thereon is not paid
when the same is due and if the taxes and assess-
ments of every nature which are or may be assessed
and levied against said premises or any part thereof
are not paid when the same are by law made due and
payable then the whole of said sum and sums and interest
thereon shall and by these presents become due and pay-
able and said party of the second part shall be entitled
to the possession of said premises And said parties of the
first part further agree upon default of the above cove-
nents and conditions or any or either of them to pay
the sum of Twenty Five Dollars for the Mortgage or
her assigns, attorney's fees for foreclosure of this mortgage
which sum shall be a lien upon said premises added
to the amount of said obligation and secured by these
presents and shall be included in and operate as a part
of the judgment upon foreclosure of this mortgage.
