This Indenture Sheweth this fifth day of June in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and eighty two between Mary F. Gilbert of Lawrence in the County of Douglas and State of Kansas of the first part and John D. A. Norton of Lawrence Kas. of the second part:

Witnesseth That the said party of the first part in consideration of the sum of Ninety five Dollars to her duly paid the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged has sold and by these presents does grant bargain sell and mortgage to the said party of the second part his heirs and assigns forever all that tract or parcel of land situated in the County of Douglas and State of Kansas described as follows to wit: Lots No. Thirty nine (39) Forty (40) Forty one (41) Forty two (42) Forty three (43) and forty four (44) in the town of Media in Palmyra Township in said County and State with the appurtenances and all the estate title and interest of the said party of the first part therein. And the said Mary F. Gilbert does hereby covenant and agree that at the delivery hereof she is the lawful owner of the premises above granted and seized of a good and indefeasible estate of inheritance therein free and clear of all incumbrances. This grant is intended as a Mortgage to secure the payment of the sum of Ninety five Dollars due on or before March 5th 1883 with interest at the rate of ten per cent per annum according to the terms of our certain promissory note this day executed and delivered by the said Mary F. Gilbert to the said party of the second part: and the said mortgage shall be void if such payment be made as is therein specified. But if default be made in such payment or any part thereof or interest thereon or the like then this mortgage shall become absolute and the whole shall become due and payable and it shall be lawful for said party of the second part his executors administrators and assigns at any time thereafter to sell the premises hereby granted or any part thereof in the manner prescribed by law appraisement hereby waived or not at the option of the party of the second part his executors administrators or assigns and out of all the money arising from such sale to retain the amount then due for principal and interest together with the costs and charges of making such sale and the surplus if any there be shall be paid by the party making such sale on demand to the said Mary F. Gilbert her heirs or assigns.
