This Indenture made this first day of September in the year of
 our Lord one thousand eight hundred and eighty two between Bridget D.
 Jennings and Thomas Jennings her husband of Cedar Township in the
 County of Douglas and State of Kansas of the first part and
 Gertrude B. Clements of same County and State of the second part:

Witnesseth That the said parties of the first part in consideration
 of the sum of Eleven Hundred and Twenty Five Dollars to them duly
 paid the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged have sold
 and by these presents do grant bargain sell and mortgage to
 the said party of the second part her heirs and assigns forever
 all that tract or parcel of land situated in the County of
 Douglas and State of Kansas described as follows to wit:

The East Sixty (60) acres of the South West quarter of Section
 Twenty three (23) in Township Thirteen (13) South of Range Eighteen
 (18) East, and commencing at the South East corner of the North
 West Quarter of said Section Twenty three (23) Town Thirteen (13) Range
 Eighteen (18) thence North Twenty & 7/8 (20 7/8) rods West Seventy
 seven (77) rods South Twenty three & 7/8 (23 7/8) rods East Seventy
 seven (77) rods to place of beginning. Also a tract of land
 described as commencing at the North East corner of the North
 West Quarter of Section Twenty six (26) in Town Thirteen (13) Range
 Eighteen (18) thence South One Hundred & Six 7/8 (106 7/8) rods thence
 West Sixty (60) rods North One Hundred & Six 7/8 (106 7/8) rods;
 thence East Sixty (60) rods to place of beginning, containing One
 hundred & Ten (110) acres more or less and subject to a first
 mortgage to secure the payment of Three hundred and Twenty
 Dollars and interest from June 20th 1882, with the appurtenances
 and all the estate title and interest of the said parties of the
 first part therein. And the said Bridget D. Jennings & Thomas
 Jennings do hereby covenant and agree that at the delivery
 hereof they are the lawful owners of the premises above granted
 and seized of a good and indefeasible estate of inheritance
 therein free and clear of all incumbrances. This Grant is intended
 as a Mortgage to secure the payment of the sum of Eleven
 Hundred and Twenty five Dollars according to the terms of three
 certain notes this day executed and delivered by the said Bridget
 D. & Thomas Jennings to the said Gertrude B. Clements payable at
 the National Bank of Lawrence Kansas as follows to wit:

Five Hundred Dollars on the first day of September 1882.
 Five Hundred Dollars on the first day of September 1884.
 One Hundred & Twenty five Dollars on the 20th day of June 1884
 with interest thereon at the rate of 8 per cent per annum to
 the said party of the second part and the same shall
