This Indenture made this twelfth day of October in the
 year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and eighty-
 two between James H. Harrison of Douglas County of the
 State of Kansas of the first part and Char. B. Smith of said
 County and State of the second part,
 Witnesseth, That the said party of the first part in
 consideration of the sum of One Thousand and Five-
 Hundred Dollars to him duly paid the receipt of
 which is hereby acknowledged has sold and by these
 presents do grant bargain sell and mortgage to the
 said party of the second part his heirs and assigns
 forever all that tract or parcel of land situated in the
 County of Douglas and State of Kansas described as
 follows to wit, Commencing 20 rods west of the South East
 corner of the South East quarter of Section 13 in Township 15
 South of Range 22. 19 East thence running west 140 rods thence
 North 160 Rods thence East 60 Rods thence South 80 Rods thence
 East 80 rods thence South 80 Rods to beginning containing One
 Hundred (100) acres more or less. Also commencing at the South
 East corner of the South West quarter of same section town
 Range, thence running west with South line of quarter sec-
 tion 43 rods thence running north var 9° East 40 rods thence
