day and date hereof made by the said Mrs. Augusta Mack
to the said E. A. Reinsch and secured to be paid by the cer-
tain promissory note of the said E. A. Reinsch bearing date
herewith payable to the order of the said Mrs. Augusta Mack
in three years from the date hereof at the office of Wm. T.
Sinclair in the City of Lawrence and State of Kansas with
interest at the rate of Eight per cent per annum from
date until paid principal sum is fully paid said interest
to be paid semiannually on the second days of April and
of October in each and every year, said several install-
ments of interest being further specified by six interest
notes or coupons of even date herewith attached to the
said note and payable at said office of Wm. T. Sinclair in
the City of Lawrence. And in and by said promissory note
it is agreed that if default be made in the payment of any
one of the installments of interest aforesaid at the time and
place aforesaid there at the election of the legal holder of said
note the said principal sum of Five-Hundred Dollars
shall at once become due and payable, anything therein
before contained to the contrary notwithstanding, such deli-
cation to be made at any time after the expiration of three
days without notice.
