witnesseth. That the said party of the first part in consideration of the sum of Eight Hundred Dollars to her duly paid the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged has sold and by these presents does grant bargain sell and mortgage to the said party of the second part his heirs and assigns forever all that tract or parcel of land situated in the County of Douglas and State of Kansas described as follows to wit, Lots numbered One Hundred and six (106), and One hundred and eight (108), on Lawrence Street in the City of Lawrence with the appurtenances and all the estate title and interest of the said party of the first part therein.
