Witnesseth That the said parties of the first part in consideration of the sum of One Hundred and Twenty five Dollars to them duly paid the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged has sold and by these presents do grant bargain sell and mortgage to the said party of the second part his heirs and assigns forever all that tract or parcel of land situated in the County of Douglas and State of Kansas described as follows to wit:

The North half of the North half of the East half of Block No. Seven (7) in Charles Addition to the City of Lawrence with the appurtenances and all the estate title and interest of the said parties of the first part therein.
