consideration of the sum of One hundred and fifty
Dollars the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged
do by these presents grant, bargain, sell and convey
unto said party of the second part his heirs and
assigns all the following described Real Estate,
situated in the County of Douglas and State of
Kansas to wit:

Lots number Ten (10) and Eleven (11) in Block
number two hundred and eighteen (218) in the
City of Eudora according to the plat of said City.

To have and to Hold the same, Together with all and
singular the tenements, hereditaments, and
appurtenances therunto belonging or, in any wise
appertaining, forever:
