Sutherland to me Mary J. Clark by an instrument in writing dated June 22nd 1885 and recorded in the office of said Register of Deeds in Vol 9 of Mortgages at page 611 on the 6th day of July 1885. Together with the bond or obligation therein described and the money due and to grow due thereon with the interest. To have and to hold the same unto the said party of the second part his heirs executors administrators and assigns forever, subject only to the proviso in the said Indenture of Mortgage mentioned. And I do hereby make constitute and appoint the said party of the second part my true and lawful attorney irrevocable in my name or otherwise but at his proper costs and charges to have use and take all lawful ways and means for the recovery of the said money and interest and in case of payment to discharge the same as fully as I might or could do if these presents were not made.
