But if default be made in the performance of any of the conditions of said bond or in the making of any payments herein provided when the same shall be due, or if the taxes and assessments of every nature which are assessed or levied against said premises are not paid at the time when the same are by law made due and payable thereupon the happening of any of said failures, the whole of the said sum of \$1000.00 together with such fines and penalties as may accrue under the by-laws of this mortgage shall immediately become due and payable and it shall be lawful for the said party of the second part or its assigns at any time thereafter to sell the premises hereby granted or any part thereof in the manner prescribed by law and out of all the moneys arising from such sale retain the amount of said bond to wit: \$1000.00 less only the amount of all dues paid as principal upon said bond together with the costs and charges of making such sale and the overplus if any there be shall be paid by the party making such sale on demand to the said Helen E. Stone her heirs and assigns.
