

a failure on their part to pay the taxes of any year before the same become delinquent then in case of the occurrence of either of said events the whole principal sum and interest shall become due and payable.

And it is further agreed by the mortgagor that if it becomes necessary to foreclose this mortgage a reasonable amount shall be allowed as attorney's fee, and be taxed as a part of the cost of foreclosing.

The said party of the first part also agrees to pay all taxes and assessments that shall be taxed or assessed on said premises from the date hereof until the said sum shall be fully paid as aforesaid.

And the said Louisa Richards and Florence H. Richards hereby relinquishes all their right of dower in and to the above described premises.
