This Indenture, Made this Thirty first day of August in the
year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and eighty
five between John L. Watts and Fannie Watts his wife
of Lawrence in the county of Douglas and State of Kansas
of the first part, and William R. Carter of the second part
Witnesseth, That the parties of the first part, in consider-
ation of the sum of Six Hundred Dollars to them duly
paid, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, have sold
and by these presents do grant, Bargain, sell and mortgage
to the said party of the second part his heirs and
assigns forever, all that tract or parcel of land situated
in the County of Douglas and State of Kansas, described
as follows to wit:

The south four (4) feet of Lot No. Sixty one (61) on Massachusetts
Street and Lot No. Sixty three (63) on New Hampshire Street, in
the City of Lawrence in said County and State according to
the plat of said city, with the appurtenances, and all the
estate, title and interest of the said parties of the first
part therein. And the said John L. Watts does hereby
covenant and agree that at the delivery hereof he is
the lawful owner of the premises above granted and
seized of a good and indefeasible estate of inheritance
therein, free and clear of all incumbrances and that
he will warrant and defend the same against all
claims whatsoever.

This Grant is intended as a Mortgage to secure
the payment of the sum of Six Hundred Dollars
according to the terms of one certain promissory note
