

This Indenture Made this seventeenth day of September
in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and
eighty five between Isaac Still and Charlotte Still his wife
of Douglas County, Kansas of the first part and W. C.
Beardsley of Auburn, New York of the second part:

Witnesseth, That that the said parties of the first part
for and in consideration of the sum of Three Hundred
and fifty Dollars to them in hand paid by the said party of
the second part the receipt whereof is hereby confessed and
acknowledged have granted, bargained, sold and conveyed
and by these presents do grant bargain sell and convey
unto the said party of the second part and to his heirs
and assigns forever, all the following described piece
and parcel of land, lying and situate in the Township
of Wanaka County of Douglas and State of Kansas
namely:

The North-East Quarter of Section No. Thirty one (31) in
Township No. Twelve (12) South of Range No. Eighteen (18) East
of the Principal Meridian containing 160 acres more or less
To have and to hold the same with all and singular
the hereditaments and appurtenances thereunto belonging
unto the party of the second part and to his heirs and
assigns forever. And the said parties of the first part do
hereby covenant and agree that at the delivery hereof they
are the lawful owners of the premises above granted and
seized of a good and indefeasible estate of inheritance
therein free and clear of all incumbrances and that they
will warrant and defend the same in the quiet and
peaceable possession of said party of the second part his
heirs and assigns forever against all persons lawfully
claiming the same.

Provided Always And these presents are upon this express
condition that whereas the said Isaac Still and Charlotte
Still are justly indebted unto the said W. C. Beardsley in
the principal sum of Three Hundred and fifty Dollars
lawful money of the United States of America being for a
loan thereof on the day and date hereof made by the
said W. C. Beardsley to the said Isaac Still and Charlotte
Still and secured to be paid by the certain promissory
note of the said parties of the first part bearing date here-
with payable to the order of the said W. C. Beardsley in
one (1) years from the date hereof at the office of W. C.
Beardsley in the City of Auburn and State of New York in
