

Release of Mortgage Recorded in Book "M" of Mtgs, at page 272.
 Whereas James M. Winton and Louisa E. Winton his wife
 by their certain deed of mortgage bearing date March 28th
 A.D. 1872 and recorded in the Register's Office of Douglas
 County in the State of Kansas conveyed to the Life
 Association of America certain real estate lying and being
 situated in said County of Douglas and described as follows
 to wit:

206th So. Four (4) and Five (5) Block Co. Eleven (11) Lance Place
 Douglas Co. Kansas which conveyance was by way of
 mortgage to secure the payment of certain notes executed
 by the said James M. Winton and made payable to the
 Life Association of America which notes are more
 particularly described in said mortgage and whereas all
 of said notes are fully paid and satisfied, Now Therefore
 this deed made and entered into this 16th day of April
 A.D. 1874 by and between the Life Association of America
 of the City and County of St. Louis in the State of Missouri
 party of the first part and James M. Winton of the County
 of Douglas in the State of Kansas party of the second part;
 Witnesseth That said party of the first part in consider-
 ation of the premises hereinbefore recited and of the sum of
 one dollar to it in hand by said party of the second part
 the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged does hereby
 release convey and forever quit-claim unto said party of
 the second part the above described real estate;

To have and to hold the same with all the appurtenances
 thereunto belonging unto him the said party of the
 second part and to his heirs and assigns forever.
