This Indenture made this 22^d day of September in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and eighty five between John R. Taylor ^{and his wife Josephine Taylor} of Lawrence in the County of Douglas and State of Kansas of the first part and John Black of the second part:

Witnesseth, That the said parties of the first part in consideration of the sum of One Hundred and Twenty five Dollars, to them duly paid the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged have sold and by these presents do grant bargain sell and mortgage to the said party of the second part his heirs and assigns forever all that tract or parcel of land situated in the County of Douglas and State of Kansas described as follows, to wit:

The South half of the South East Quarter of the North West Quarter of Section number Twenty seven (27) Township Fourteen (14) Range Twenty (20) and containing Twenty (20) acres more or less, with the appurtenances and all the estate title and interest of the said parties of the first part therein. And the said John R. Taylor and Josephine Taylor do hereby covenant and agree that at the delivery hereof they are the lawful owners of the premises above granted and seized of a good and indefeasible estate of inheritance therein free and clear of all incumbrances. This grant is intended as a Mortgage to secure the payment of the sum of One Hundred and Twenty five Dollars (\$25⁰⁰) said sum being a part of the purchase money due for said premises and payable as follows to wit: Sixty two & 00/100 in one year from date hereof and Sixty two and 50/100 Dollars in two years from date hereof with interest at ten per cent per annum according to the terms of two certain promissory notes this day executed and delivered by the said John R. Taylor and Josephine Taylor to the said party of the second part
