

And this conveyance shall be void if such payment be made as herein specified. But if default be made in such payment or any part thereof or interest thereon or the taxes are not kept up thereon then this conveyance shall become absolute and the whole shall become due and payable and it shall be lawful for said party of the second part his executors administrators and assigns at any time thereafter to sell the premises hereby granted or any part thereof in the manner prescribed by law appraisement hereby waived or not at the option of the party of the second part his executors administrators or assigns at any time thereafter to sell the premises hereby granted or any part thereof in the manner prescribed by law appraisement hereby waived or not at the option of the party of the second part his executors administrators or assigns and out of all the moneys arising from such sale to retain the amount then due for principal and interest together with the costs and charges of making such sale and the surplus if any there be shall be paid by the party making such sale on demand to the said parties of the first part or their heirs and assigns.
