

Warrant and Defend the same in the quiet and
peaceable possession of said party of the second part, his
heirs and assigns forever, against all persons lawfully
claiming the same.

Provided Always, And these presents are upon this
express condition, that whereas the said Parties of the
first part are justly indebted unto the said W. C.
Beardsley in the principal sum of Fourteen Hundred
Dollars lawful money of the United States of America,
being for a loan thereon, on the day and date hereof
made by the said W. C. Beardsley to the said Parties
of the first part and secured to be paid by two
certain promissory notes of the said Parties of the first
part bearing even date hereunto payable to the order
of the said W. C. Beardsley in $\frac{1}{2}$ and three years from
the date hereof at the office of W. C. Beardsley in the
City of Auburn and State of New York with interest at
the rate of Eight per cent. per annum, from date until
said principal sum is fully paid, said interest to
be paid semi-annually on the 29th day of September
and of March in each and every year, said several
installments of interest being further specified by
interest notes or coupons of even date hereunto attached
to each of said notes and payable at said office of
W. C. Beardsley in the City of Auburn New York and
in and by said promissory notes it is agreed that
if default be made in the payment of any one
of the installments of interest aforesaid at the time
and place aforesaid, then at the election of the
legal holder of said notes the said principal sum
of Fourteen Hundred Dollars with all the interest
thereon, shall at once become due and payable
anything thereinbefore contained to the contrary
notwithstanding, such election to be made at any
time after the expiration of three days, without notice.

Now, if the said parties of the first part shall
well and truly pay or cause to be paid the
said sums of money in said notes mentioned
with the interest thereon, according to the tenor
and effect of said notes, then these presents shall
be null and void. But if said sums of money
or any interest thereon, is not paid when the
same is due and payable, or if any taxes or
