This Indenture, Made this 23<sup>rd</sup> day of September in  
the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred  
and eighty five between Rittie Patterson and Henry  
C. Patterson her husband of Vinland in the County  
of Douglas and State of Kansas, of the first part, and  
Frederick E. Brooks and Royal L. Bradshaw Partners  
as Brooks and Bradshaw of the second part:

Witnesseth, That the <sup>said</sup> part of the first part, in  
consideration of the sum of Five Hundred \$500<sup>00</sup>  
Dollars to them duly paid, the receipt of which  
is hereby acknowledged have sold and by these  
presents do grant, bargain, sell and mortgage to the  
said parties of the second part their heirs and  
assigns forever, all that tract or parcel of land  
situated in the County of Douglas and State of  
Kansas, described as follows, to wit:

Lot Number Nine (9) in Block number One (1) all  
in the Town of Vinland Douglas County State of  
Kansas as numbered and designated on the  
Recorded Plat of said Town, with the appurtenances  
and all the estate, title and interest of the said  
parties of the first part therein. And the said  
Rittie Patterson and Henry C. Patterson do hereby  
covenant and agree that at the delivery hereof  
they are the lawful owners of the premises  
above granted and seized of a good and indef-  
easible estate of inheritance therein, free and  
clear of all incumbrances and that they will  
warrant and defend the same against all claims  
whatever. This Grant is intended as a Mortgage  
to secure the payment of the sum of Five  
Hundred (\$500<sup>00</sup>) Dollars according to the terms  
of one certain promissory note this day executed  
by the said Rittie Patterson and Henry C. Patterson  
to the said parties of the second part. Said  
note being given for the sum of Five Hundred  
(\$500<sup>00</sup>) Dollars dated September 23, 1885 due and  
payable in Three years from date thereof  
with interest thereon from the date thereof  
until paid according to the terms of said  
note and coupons thereto attached. And this  
conveyance shall be void if such payment  
be made as in said note and coupons
