 hereby acknowledged, has sold, and by these presents
 does grant, bargain, sell and mortgage to the said
 party of the second part his heirs and assigns
 forever, all that tract or parcel of land situated in
 the County of Douglas and State of Kansas, described
 as follows, to wit:

The north half of Lot No. One on Massachusetts
 street in the City of Lawrence State of Kansas with
 the appurtenances, and all the estate, title and interest
 of the said parties of the first part therein. And
 the said Absalom Dinnery does hereby covenant and
 agree that at the delivery hereof he is the lawful
 owner of the premises above granted, and seized of
 a good and indefeasible estate of inheritance therein
 free and clear of all incumbrance.

This Grant is intended as a Mortgage to secure
 the payment of the sum of Four Hundred and
 Eighteen Dollars for purchase money according to the
 terms of four certain promissory notes this day
 executed and delivered by the said Absalom Dinnery
 to the said party of the second part: and this
