Davis (husband and wife) of St. Louis in the County of St. Louis and State of Missouri of the first part and Benjamin B. Thomas and Emaline P. Thomas of the second part:

Witnesseth, That the said parties of the first part in consideration of the sum of Eighteen Hundred Dollars to them duly paid the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged have sold and by these presents do grant bargain sell and mortgage to the said parties of the second part their heirs and assigns forever all that tract or parcel of land situated in the County of Douglas and State of Kansas described as follows to wit:
