Witnesseth, That said party of the first part in consideration of the sum of Three Hundred (\$300) Dollars the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged does by these presents grant bargain sell and convey unto said party of the second part his heirs and assigns all the following described real estate situated in the County of Douglas and State of Kansas, to wit:

The West  $\frac{1}{2}$  of the North East  $\frac{1}{4}$  of Section No. Two (2) Township No. Fourteen (14) South of Range No. Twenty (20) East of 6<sup>th</sup> P.M. Kansas, 80 acres more or less, To have and to hold the same together with all the tenements, hereditaments, and appurtenances thereunto belonging or in any wise appertaining forever.

Provided Always and these presents are upon this express condition that whereas said George H. Hornell has this day executed and delivered his certain promissory note in writing to said party of the second part of which the following is a copy:
