in the year of our Lord one thousand eight  
hundred and eighty five between H. C. Wade  
and Louise M. Wade husband and wife of

of Kansas, of the first part, and L. B. Hewitt  
of the second part:

Witnesseth, That the said parties of the first part  
in consideration of the sum of Six Hundred  
Dollars to them duly paid, the receipt of which  
is hereby acknowledged, have sold and by these  
presents do grant, bargain, sell and mortgage to the  
said party of the second part her heirs and  
assigns forever, all that tract or parcel of land  
situated in the County of Douglas and State of Kansas,  
described as follows, to wit:

The North Half of the North west quarter of Section  
Twenty Two (22) Township Twelve (12) Range Nineteen  
(19) containing 80 acres, with the appurtenances, and
