

This indenture, made this 15 day of October in the year of our Lord One Thousand, Eight Hundred and Eighty five between J. M. Starr of Baldwin in the County of Douglas and State of Kansas of the first part, and W. W. Junkins of the second part, witnesseth, That the said parties of the first part, in consideration of the sum of Seven hundred \$700 Dollars to be duly paid, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, have sold, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and mortgage to the said parties of the second part their heirs and assigns forever, all that tract and parcel of land situated in the County of Douglas and State of Kansas, described as follows, to wit:

East half $\frac{1}{2}$ of south west fourth $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section Sixty nine (29) Township fourteen (4) Range twenty (20) also Lot eighty one (81) High St. Baldwin City Kans. with the appurtenances and all the estate title and interest of the said parties of the first part therein. And the said J. M. Starr & Hulda his wife and H. S. Starr do hereby covenant and agree that at the delivery hereof they are the lawful owners of the premises above granted, and seized of a good and indefeasible estate of inheritance therein free and clear of all incumbrances.

This grant is intended as a Mortgage to secure the payment of the sum of Seven hundred dollars according to the terms of a certain obissory note this day executed by the said parties of the first part to the said party of the second part. And this conveyance shall be void if such payment be made as is herein specified. But if default be made in such payment, or any part thereof, or interest thereon where the taxes on said land are not paid when the same become due and payable, or if the insurance is not kept up thereon, as provided herein then this conveyance shall become absolute, and the whole sum remaining unpaid shall immediately become due and payable, at the option of the holder thereof: and it shall be lawful for said part of the second part his executors,

Know all men by these presents, That in consideration of free payment of the debt incurred by the note herein described having been paid this mortgage is hereby released and the like hereby created is discharged.
