

This Indenture, Made this 24 day of November A.D.
 1885 between Joseph O. Roberts and Angeline Roberts his
 wife, both of Jefferson County, in the State of Kansas
 of the first part, and Nathaniel S. Jones of Cook
 County, in the State of Illinois of the second part
 Witnesseth, That said parties of the first part
 in consideration of the sum of \$1500. Fifteen hundred
 Dollars the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged
 do by these presents, grant, bargain, sell and convey
 unto said party of the second part, his heirs and
 assigns, all the following described Real Estate
 situated in the County of Douglas and State of
 Kansas, to wit:

Commencing at a point in the quarter section line
 twenty (20) rods south of the center corner of section
 No. Thirty six (36) in Township No. Twelve (12) south of
 Range No. Nineteen (19) east: thence south along
 said quarter section line twenty eight (28) rods,
 two and one half ($\frac{1}{2}$) feet to a point in said
 line: thence east Fifty one (51) rods to a point; thence
 North Twenty eight (28) rods, two and one half ($\frac{1}{2}$)
 feet: thence west Fifty one (51) rods to the place of
 beginning - containing nine acres of land more
 or less.

To have and to hold the same, together with all
 and singular the tenements, hereditaments, and
 appurtenances thereto belonging, or in any wise
 appertaining, forever:

Provided Always, And these presents are upon
 this express condition, that whereas said Joseph
 O. Roberts and Angeline Roberts his wife have
 this day executed and delivered a certain promissory
 note in writing to said party of the second
 part, of which the following is a copy:
 \$1500. On, or before the first day of January
 eighteen hundred ninety one (1891) we promise to
 pay Nathaniel S. Jones or order the sum of
 fifteen hundred (1500) dollars, for value received.
 This note is to bear no interest.
